Scholarship Applications 2017: Important Information

Year 13 and DAEU Students:

- Current <u>Year 13</u> students studying in Vanuatu (South Pacific Form Seven; Baccalauréat); and <u>DAEU</u> students (Lycee LAB/AUF) <u>who meet eligibility criteria</u>, including minimum academic standards in their end of year results, will be <u>automatically eligible to be considered</u> for a scholarship (provided scholarship funding is available).
- Therefore current <u>Year 13</u> students studying in Vanuatu (South Pacific Form Seven; Baccalauréat); and <u>DAEU</u> students (Lycee LAB/AUF) <u>will</u> <u>NOT be required to fill out a Scholarship Application form.</u>
- An Information Sheet will be sent to all **Year 13** and **DAEU institutions** clearly explaining the new scholarship processes.
- Current Year 13 Ni-Vanuatu students who are studying overseas (e.g. Fiji, New Caledonia), and wish to be considered for a Vanuatu Government scholarship will need to submit an information form to the Scholarship Office (contact details, examination information). This form will be available on request from the Scholarships Office by July 31st 2016. The form will need to be returned to the Scholarships Office by Friday, September 2, 2016.

All Other Applicants:

 Applications from all other applicants (who are currently not Year 13 or DAEU students) will be called for on <u>August 1 2016</u>. Applications will close on <u>4.30pm</u>, <u>Friday</u>, <u>September 2 2016</u>.

Eligibility Criteria:

 Eligibility, academic criteria, and scholarship priorities for all scholarships are currently under review by the Scholarships Office.

 Finalised eligibility, academic criteria and scholarship priorities will be made publicly available by <u>July 31st 2016</u>.
