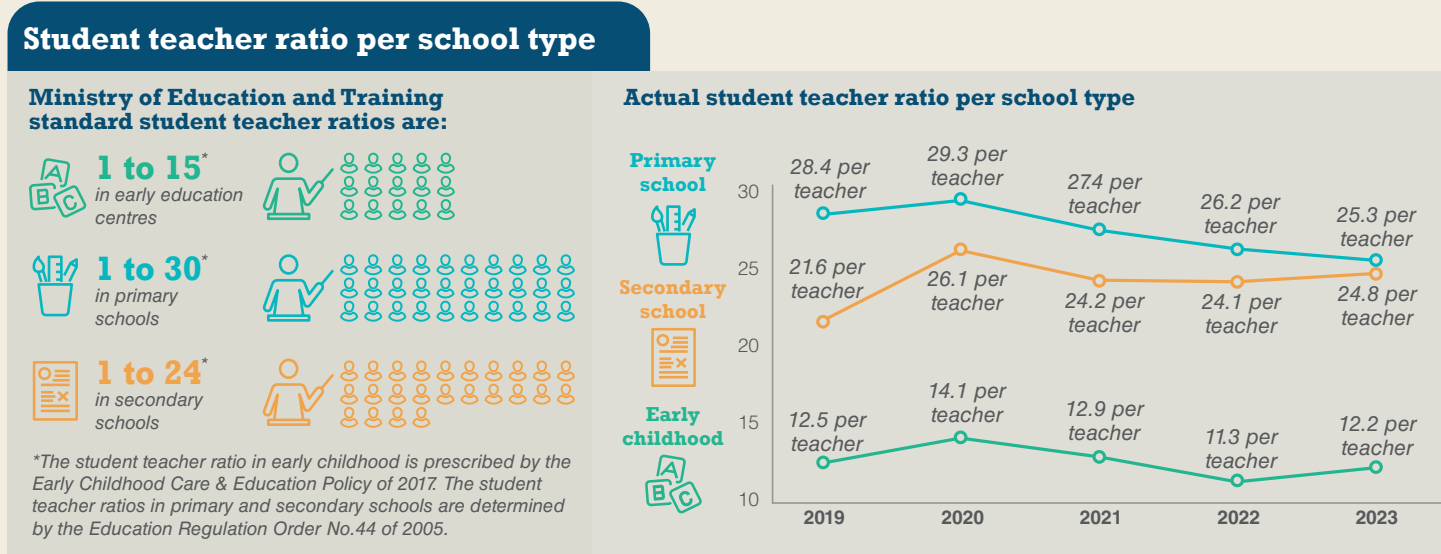
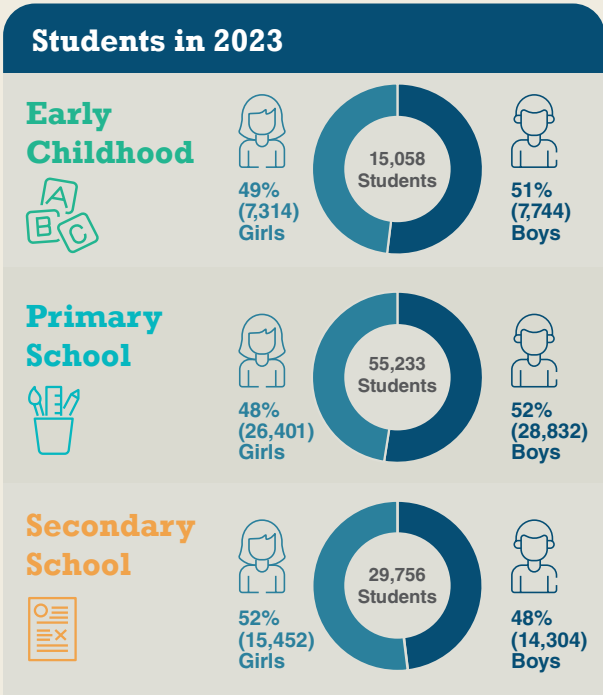
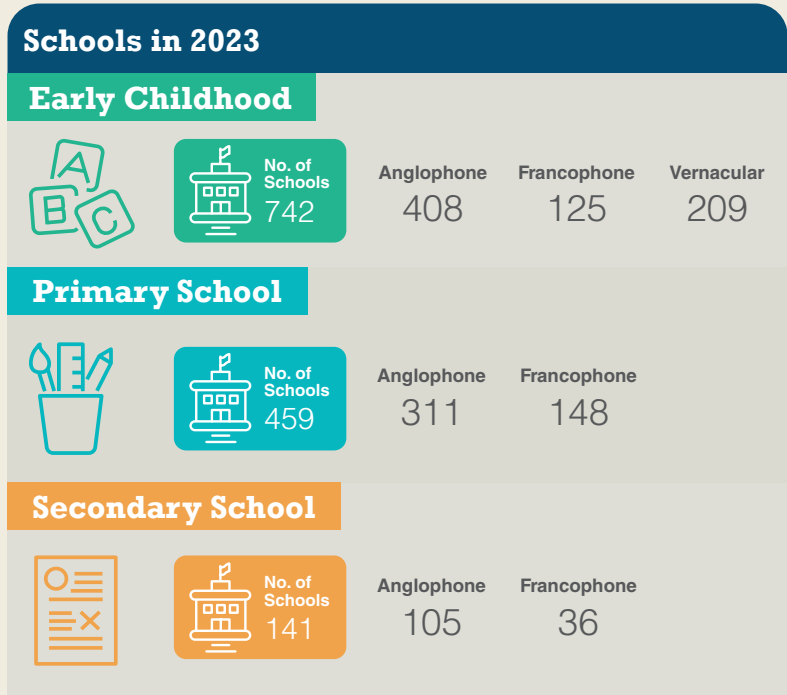




2023 Education Key Indicators

Number of teachers per school type

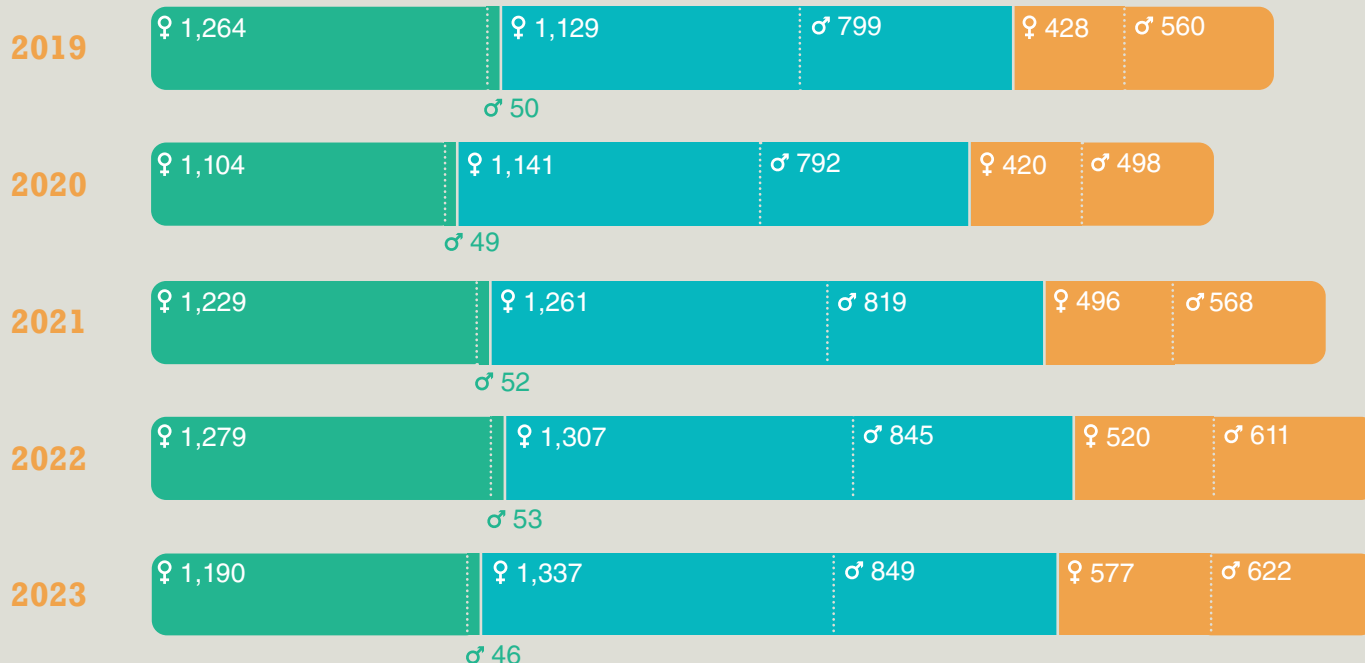

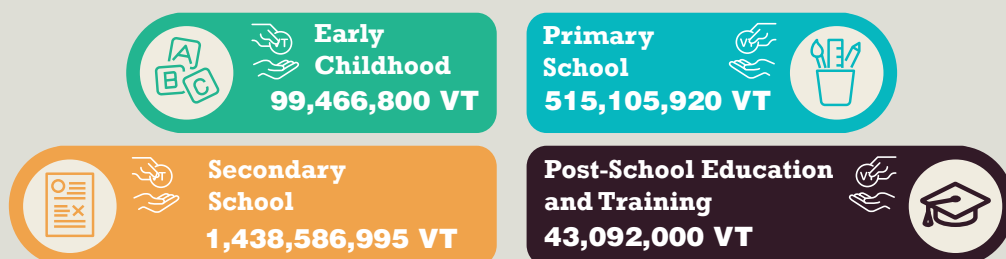

13% contributions from donor partners



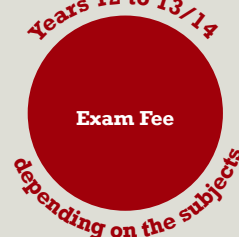
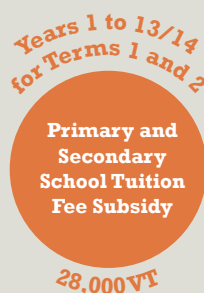
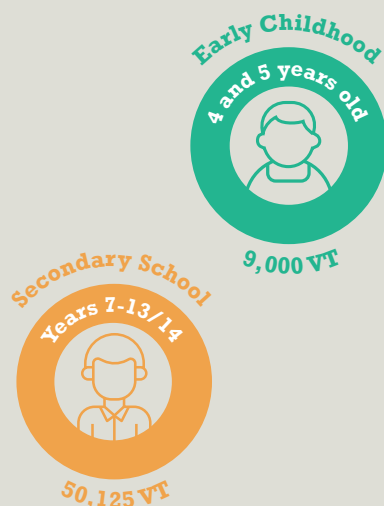
